Norwalk, CT – The Dr. Robert E. Appleby School Based Health Centers will be offering summer hours for Norwalk Public School 9<sup>th</sup> grade entry physicals, as well as fall sports physicals. Physicals will be held from July 26, 2010 - August 6, 2010 from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm at Brien McMahon High School. Physicals are available by appointment only. Any student playing or considering playing a fall sport must have a physical dated after July 1, 2010 per Norwalk Public Schools. All calls will be returned within the next business day.
